

Sanctification – is one of those big theological words that confuse people. According to The Interpreter's Dictionary of the Bible, it is "the realization or progressive attainment of likeness to God or to God's intention for humanity. It may be regarded both as a status conferred by divine grace, and as a goal toward which to aim." Surely, it is NOT a one-time event, and it is the focus of our gospel lesson from John ch. 17.

This chapter is Jesus' high priestly prayer which naturally falls into 3 parts: Jesus' prayer for himself, Jesus' prayer for his disciples who will be left in the world following his ascension, and Jesus' prayer for the universal church. Today's lesson is

the 2nd part of this prayer. Let us remember that we are among Jesus' disciples for whom he prayed, and then let us take up the call to service for which we are prepared.



I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours. John 17:9 'I have made your name known to those whom you gave me from the world. They were yours, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything you have given me is from you; for the words that you gave to me I have given to them, and they have received them and know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me. I am asking on their behalf; I am not asking on behalf of the world, but on behalf of those whom you

gave me, because they are yours. All mine are yours, and yours are mine; and I have been glorified in them.

And now I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one, as we are one. While I was with them, I protected them in your name that you have given me. I guarded them, and not one of them was lost except the one destined to be lost, so that the scripture might be fulfilled. But now I am coming to you, and I speak these things in the world so that they may have my joy made complete in themselves. I have given them your word, and the world has hated them because they do not belong to the world, just as I do not belong to the world. I am not asking you to take them out of the world, but I ask you to protect them from the evil one. They do not belong to the world, just as I do not belong to the world. Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. As you have sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. And for their sakes I sanctify myself, so that they also may be sanctified in truth.

Affirmation of Faith

A Portion of *The Westminster Confession of Faith (1647)*6.043 Of Christ the Mediator

It pleased God, in his eternal purpose, to choose and ordain the Lord Jesus, his only begotten Son, to be the Mediator between God and man, the prophet, priest, and kind; the head and Savior of his Church, the heir of all things, and judge of the world; unto whom he did, from all eternity, give a people to be his seed, and to be by him in time redeemed, called, justified, sanctified, and glorified.

The Son of God, the second Person in the Trinity, being very and eternal God, of one substance, and equal with the Father, did, when the fullness of time was come, take upon him man's nature, with all the essential properties and common infirmities thereof; yet without sin; being conceived by the power of the Holy Ghost, in the womb of the Virgin Mary, of her substance. So that two whole, perfect, and distinct natures, the Godhead and the manhood, were inseparably joined together in one person, without conversion, composition, or confusion. Which person is very God and very man, yet one Christ, the only Mediator between God and man.


