

Preparing Ourselves for Worship During the Musical Prelude ...



Most of us spend more time **sitting** in chairs than **thinking about** chairs, but perhaps we devote even more time to **hunting for** the perfect chair. There's a whole book about that pursuit – "Now I Sit Me Down by architect, Witold Rybczynski. He explains that the history of chairs is a social history – of different ways of sitting, of changing manners and attitudes and of varying tastes. He also says that the search for the perfect chair will never end, because humans aren't built to sit. He said, "We are good at walking and running, and we are happy lying down. But it is the in-between

position that is the problem."

A pastor, while visiting an active retired couple, noticed that both of them were almost always busy at some project. When the pastor commented about their activity level, the man replied, "When my brother retired at 65, he went out on the front porch and sat down. That's where he was most of the time. And within three years, he was dead. I don't think we're made to sit for long." Consider the impact this frame of mind has on the Great Commission disciples of Christ are given.
